

Convention Information

Conditions of entry:

Entry to MOAB is conditional upon the acceptance and adherence to the following conditions, which apply to all individuals, groups, retailers or other persons seeking entry to or who are present on the premises (being the Sylvania Heights Community and Youth Club, Box Rd Sylvania Heights) upon which MOAB is conducted:

- Children under 16 years must be supervised by their parents/carers at all times.
- No weapons, real or otherwise, are permitted on the premises.
- No illicit drugs are permitted on the premises.
- No smoking is permitted on the premises.
- No offensive behaviour, offensive clothing or offensive item is permitted on the premises.
- No items are to be sold on the premises other than through the Bring and Buy or through the retailers who attend the convention. If you want to sell something privately please do it outside the premises.

The convention organiser, or his representatives, reserves the right to refuse entry to any person or item contravening the above conditions or at its unfettered discretion generally and reserves the right to remove any person or item at its unfettered discretion or that in the organisers or his representatives opinion, or at the request of a member of the Executive of the Sylvania Heights Community and Youth Club, or following a complaint is found to contravene any of the above conditions, or that it wishes to remove at its unfettered discretion generally. Reference: Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 No 33, 4 & 4a.

Registrations:

Registration for competitions may be made online via our website or by mailing in an entry form. Only one person may enter per online registration or form. Registration and payment secures your entry, positions permitting. Entry forms can be downloaded from the MOAB website.

Payments:

Registration payments may be made when registering online or by including a cheque or money order when mailing in an entry. Note that manual credit card payments will attract a processing fee.

Competition Cancellation

If insufficient entries for a competition have been received 10 working days prior to MOAB start date, the competition may be subject to cancellation. Typically a competition requires a minimum of 5 paid registrations to go ahead unless arrangements have been made with the Convention Organiser.

Late Entry Fee:

A late entry fee of \$10.00 applies to all entries received on the day (1st October) and only if there are any vacancies.

Refund Policy:

Cancellations received prior to 18th September 2011 **WILL** receive a refund less any Bank, Paypal or other administration charges. Cancellations received after this date **MAY** receive a refund, less any Bank, Paypal or other administration charges, at the organiser's discretion.
